NEWSLETTER MINUTES

Marilyn Porter, president, called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m. Other board members present were Sheryl Frank, vice president; Ray Gamble, secretary-treasurer; Ed Korte and Mike Gamble.

Also attending were Alexis Martin, on-site manager; Beth Webb, assistant manager; Mike Leach, maintenance superintendent; Melva Linville, property manager with Linville Management Services, Inc.; and Dudley Leonard, cooperative attorney.

Minutes of the October 18 board meeting were approved.

There will be no December meeting. The next meeting is January 17, 2012.

Open Session

Appearing for the open session at 6 p.m. were Lorie Marler, Jean Hudgens, Greg Brush, Jessie Phillips, Bea Parks, Mirtha Abreu and German Mangandi.

Mike gave the maintenance report. From October 18 to November 15, 112 work orders were called in and 97 were completed. One bath faucet and one water heater have been replaced.

There have been three move-ins and one move-out. Furnace inspections have been completed and maintenance is cleaning up leaves throughout the property.

Alexis gave the office updates. There have been 23 statements of charges due, two attorney referrals, 19 defaults, one intent to vacate and one animal violation.

Eighteen units are for sale. Eight of these are vacant. Three move-ins are scheduled. Four applications are in process.

Marilyn recognized three members with referral bonuses of \$200: Porfirio Figueroa, Greg Brush and Mirtha Abreu.

Marilyn opened the floor to member comments.

Jessie Phillips won the door prize drawing of a \$25 gift card.

Marilyn thanked members for attending and the open session ended at 6:20 p.m.

The board reviewed and approved a referral acknowledgment letter to be used by the office staff in thanking members.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:35 p.m.
