BOARD MEETING, February 21, 2012

NEWSLETTER MINUTES

Sheryl Frank, vice president, called the meeting to order at 5:45 p.m. Other board members present were Ray Gamble, secretary-treasurer; Ed Korte and Mike Gamble.

Also attending were Alexis Martin, on-site manager; Martha Ramcke, assistant manager; Mike Leach, maintenance superintendent; Dudley Leonard, cooperative attorney; Suzanne Miles, human relations coordinator, and Betsy Kilker, administrative assistant, with Linville Management Services, Inc.

Minutes of the January 17 board meeting were approved.

Open Session

Eight members signed in for the open session at 6 p.m. They were Bobbie Wensell, Bea Parks, Jessie Phillips, Cheryl Cooper, Mary Dolman, Chelle Marler, Jean Hudgens and Jana Nevins.

Sheryl welcomed them and introduced Martha as the new assistant manager.

Mike gave the maintenance report. From January 17 through February 21, 104 work orders were called in and 92 completed.

Replaced were two ranges, one refrigerator, one garbage disposal and one water heater.

There have been three move-ins and one move-out since the last meeting. Spring clean-up of the grounds will begin on March 1.

Alexis gave the office updates. There have been 21 statements of charges due, three attorney referrals, 19 defaults, three animal violations, three intents to vacate and two vehicle violations.

Eleven units are for sale. Only one of those units is not paying carrying charges. Three move-ins and two application appointments are scheduled and one application is in process.

Sheryl recognized Jean Hudgens as the Good Neighbor of the Month for February. She was nominated by Chelle Marler.

Martha recognized Sheryl for a referral bonus of \$200.

Sheryl opened the floor to member comments.

Jean Hudgens won the door prize drawing of a \$25 gift card.

Sheryl thanked members for attending and the open session ended at 6:25 p.m.

Closed Session

Sheryl signed the Independence Square tax return.

Alexis, Martha and Mike were allowed to leave at 7:45 p.m.

The board convened for executive session at 7:50 p.m. The meeting was adjourned at 8:10 p.m.
