The new lawn crew started on July 1.

Flower beds need to have clear boundaries. Blocks and pavers are available from the maintenance shop to create a boundary.

There were eight emergency call-outs, 105 new service requests and 141 completed service requests.

Completed were 17 appliance repairs, 46 plumbing, 14 general maintenance, one roofing, eight emergency call-outs, 14 doors and trim, five electrical, 24 HVAC, five exterminations, nine exterior projects and four basement repairs.

Three rehabs are underway and five more are expected.

Lawns are inspected every Tuesday. Pet waste and grass height are the most common violations.
